NOTICE TO MARINERS

1. Below-water surveys and above-water inspections around selected turbines at Moray East Wind Farm

Please be advised that Moray Offshore Windfarm (East) Limited (Moray East) are planning to undertake Balance of Plant(BoP) inspection. This will include below-water geophysical surveys around selected Wind Turbine Generator (WTG) and along selected Inter-array cables (IAC) and Interconnector cable routes sections. The vessel will also undertake above-water inspections at all WTG locations. The survey vessel to be used is the Windcat 19, detailed below. Activities are expected to take place between 09/08/2024 and 01/11/2024.




Figure 1 Moray East Site Layout

2. General Safety advice

Please be aware that, during the survey activities, by virtue of its mode of operation the vessel will be Restricted in her Ability to Manoeuvre (RAM) as defined under COLREGs (International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972, Rule 3). Masters of vessels are therefore requested to maintain their vessels and gears at a minimum safe passing distance from the vessel of 500 metres when it is undertaking work and showing the appropriate shapes and lights in accordance with COLREGs Rule 27.

In order to not compromise the safety of the Survey Vessel, their crew, and their ability to undertake its contracted works, fishermen who have static fishing gears deployed within 500 m from the WTG and 1km from the cables where survey activities are planned (see Figure 1) are requested to provide the coordinates of such deployed gears in DMS and details of whether the surface markers used are visible at all states of visibility to Alex Winrow-Griffin (Brown & May Marine) using the contact information below (Section 58 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1995).

Fishermen who have static gears deployed beyond 12 nm are reminded that static gear must be marked in accordance with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 404/2011
